

*******CITY HALL CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC*******

The Governor has issued a directive that all non-essential local government staff be cut by 50% for the next **2 weeks** due to COVID-19. This will affect City Hall, DPW and Code Enforcement. Fire and Police will not be affected, as they are essential personnel.

As of now City Hall will be **closed to the public**. Payments can be made online at www.norwichnewyork.net, by mail or in the drop box at the front door of City Hall.

If you are looking for a vital record such as Birth, Death or Marriage certificate, this will need to be done by mailing a NOTARIZED request. Instructions can be found on the Clerk's page of the City website listed above. No marriage licenses will be issued for at least the next 2 weeks.
