CHAPTER 525

ARTICLE III VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC

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History: Adopted by the Common Council of the City of Norwich; Part 1, 12-27-27 as Ordinance II of the General Ordinances of the City of Norwich; Part 2, 12-28-48; Part 3, 5-11-15 as Ordinance IX of the General Ordinances of the City of Norwich; Part 4, as individual resolutions. Amended on November 18, 1997. Amendments noted where applicable.

Part 1 General Provisions

A. Highway Law; Enforcement

Section 525-11. General Highway Traffic Law.

The several provisions of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law (NYSVTL) are hereby made a part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Norwich. However, violations of the provisions of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law (NYSVTL) shall be prosecuted and punished as provided in such law.

Section 525-12. Police Authority.

The Police Department is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enforce the provisions of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law (NYSVTL), all other general laws relating to traffic and the traffic ordinances of the City of Norwich, New York.

Section 525-13. Blank Section.

B. Common Council: Powers and Duties

Section 525-14. Powers and Duties of Common Council.

The Common Council shall have power and it shall be its duty from time to time to make, promulgate and enforce reasonable rules and regulations governing and designating parking, parking spaces, fire lanes, parking meter zones, safety zones, loading zones, one-way streets and streets for through traffic.

- A. Such rules and regulations of the Common Council shall be in writing and signed by the Mayor or acting Mayor in triplicate, and filed in the office of the City Clerk, office of the Chief of Police and the City Court. The City Clerk shall furthermore furnish the daily newspapers of the city with copies of such rules and regulations as soon as filed.
- B. The Common Council shall cause to be erected or placed by the Department of Public Works under the direction of the Police Department suitable and conspicuous signs designating such parking spaces, fire lanes, parking meter zones, safety zones, loading zones, one-way streets in the manner prescribed by the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law (NYSVTL). Such signs when so placed and erected are hereby declared to be an order and direction of the Police Department regulating traffic.

Section 525-15. One-Way Traffic.

One-way streets for one-way traffic shall include such streets as may be set apart by the Common Council for the movement of traffic in one (1) direction.

Section 525-16. Loading Zones.

Loading zones shall mean that portion of the street set apart and designated by the Common Council for the loading and unloading of vehicles.

Section 525-17. Streets.

A. The Common Council shall have the right and it may designate, establish and maintain certain streets in the City as through streets for through traffic and shall erect and maintain upon all street intersections of such streets proper and suitable signs reading "Stop" and it shall be the duty of drivers of all vehicles to COME TO A FULL STOP upon approaching

such through street intersections and to proceed into or across such streets with extreme care and caution.

B. The Common Council may by resolution designate certain public highways or parts of highways, respectively in such City of Norwich as main arteries of travel and require that all vehicles approaching a main artery of travel on any public highway designated by ordinance shall, before entering the same, come to a full stop unless directed by a peace officer or signal. The operator of any vehicle which has come to a stop as herein required entering the main artery of travel, as well as the operator of a vehicle on such main artery of travel, shall be subject to the right-of-way regulations presented by this chapter and the NYSVTL and shall enter such main arteries of travel with caution.

Signs bearing the word "STOP" shall be erected and maintained at or near the intersecting line of such main arteries of travel on all public highways designated by ordinance on which vehicles shall before entering such main arteries of travel come to a full stop. Signs erected shall conform with the manual of "Uniform Traffic Control Devices".

C. Restriction on Vehicles and Movements

Section 525-18. Right of Way.

When in the performance of duty, the fire apparatus, police patrols and ambulances shall have the right of way over all other vehicles.

Section 525-19. Approaching Pedestrians.

Vehicles approaching pedestrians upon the traveled part of any street, and not upon the sidewalk, and on approaching an intersecting street or curve, shall slow down and proceed with extreme care. Pedestrians proceeding lawfully across street within a marked crosswalk or in any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall have right of way over vehicles.

Section 525-20. Obstructing Traffic or Driveways.

No vehicles shall be allowed to turn on or be driven through any street so as to willfully block the traffic on such street or obstruct the driveway entrance to any premises.

Section 525-21. Repairing Vehicles on Roadway.

No person shall repair any piece of motor apparatus or any vehicle in any street or public place except in case of accident or emergency.

Section 525-22. Weight Limits for Vehicles.

No vehicle or combination of shall be operated or moved on any highway or bridge thereon within the City of Norwich of a size or weight exceeding the limitation provided for in the NYSVTL.

Section 525-23. Blocking Sidewalks.

No person shall place or park any bicycle, tricycle, motorcycle, motor vehicle or other vehicle upon any sidewalk or across the same.

Section 525-24. Driving on Sidewalks or Crosswalks.

No person shall drive any vehicle upon any sidewalk of the city except when reasonable or necessary: to gain access to a public highway, private way or lands or buildings adjacent to such highway or way; in the conduct of work upon a highway, or upon a private way or lands or buildings adjacent to such highway or way; to plow snow or perform any other public service, for hire, or otherwise, which

could not otherwise be reasonably and properly performed. No vehicle shall be stopped upon any crosswalk so as to obstruct the passage of pedestrians.

Section 525-25. Signals.

Driver of vehicle must use manufacturer equipped signals to display intention of turning or braking.

Section 525-26. Traffic Officers or Flag Persons.

At times when traffic officers or flag persons are on duty, vehicles, at all times, shall be under the supervision and control of said officers and shall not cross streets until signaled by said traffic officer. The personal order and direction of a police officer shall be obeyed, taking precedence over mechanical signals.

Section 525-27. Pedestrians at Crosswalks.

At crossing outside of traffic signal area where no traffic officer is present directing traffic, pedestrians having left the curb at a marked crosswalk and moving directly across the street in the direction of the opposite curb shall be deemed to have the right of way over all vehicular traffic.

No pedestrian shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close that it is impractical for the driver to yield.

Section 525-28. Only Authorized Persons to Direct Traffic.

No person other than those authorized shall exhibit a sign or standard of any type upon any street or in any public place in any attempt to regulate traffic or the parking of vehicles.

Section 525-29. Motorcycle and Motorbike Operation Within the City of Norwich.

Any motorcycle or motorbike operated within the City of Norwich shall be required to have both wheels upon the road surface or pavement at all times, thereby outlawing the practice commonly known as "wheelies".

D. Parking Regulations

Section 525-30. Areas Where Parking Prohibited.

No vehicle shall be parked at any time within the following areas.

- 1. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped, standing or parked at the edge or curb of a street.
- 2. On a sidewalk.
- 3. On a crosswalk.
- 4. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic.
- 5. Upon any bridge.
- 6. On any railroad tracks.
- 7. In front of a public or private driveway.
- 8. Within twenty feet of a crosswalk at an intersection unless a different distance indicated by official signs, markings or parking meters.
- 9. Within twenty feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station and, when on the side of the street opposite to the entrance of any fire station, within seventy-five feet of said entrance, when properly sign posted, unless a different distance is indicated by official signs, markings or parking meters.
- 10. Alongside or obstructing a curb area which has been cut down, lowered or constructed so as to provide accessibility to the sidewalk.

- 11. Except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers, within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing, unless a different distance is indicated by official signs, markings or parking meters.
- 12. Within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant.

Section 525-31. Handicapped Parking.

- A. No vehicle shall park in any parking space in any municipal parking lot under custody and control of the City of Norwich or in any parking space upon a city street which shall be designated by appropriate signage as hereinafter provided as a space reserved for handicapped parking unless such vehicle shall have an appropriately displayed license or permit as being one used by a handicapped person as provided under the state Vehicle and Traffic Law.
- B. The Common Council does hereby designate the following number of spaces reserved for handicapped parking. (7/21/98)

C. All handicapped parking shall be three hour designated parking. (7/21/98)

E. Speed

Section 525-32. Speed of Vehicles.

- A. No vehicle except fire apparatus, police patrol vehicles and ambulances shall be driven or operated in the city at a rate of speed greater than thirty (30) miles per hour.
- B. Except as provided in subsection A. of this section, no vehicle shall be driven or operated in a school zone at a rate of speed greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour during school days between 7 AM and 6 PM.

Section 525-33. Blank Section.

F. Trains

Section 525-34. Speed of Trains Within City; Violations and Penalties.

No railway train shall be operated in the city at a rate of speed greater than twenty (20) miles per hour (mph).

Section 525-35. Trains Obstructing Streets or Walks.

No train of cars or part of any train of cars, including the locomotive or tender thereof shall remain or be left across or upon any of the streets or walks of the city so as to prevent free and unobstructed travel along the same for a longer period of time than five (5) consecutive minutes. Any officer, agent or employee of any railroad company, or any person having charge or control of any such train or of the locomotive, who shall violate or suffer or allow any violation of this section, shall pay a penalty of not less than fifty dollars (\$50).

Section 525-36. Blank Section.

G. Broad Street Arterial Highway

Section 525-37. Rules and Regulations Applicable.

The following rules and regulations are hereby made applicable to the Broad Street Arterial Highway from the intersection of North Broad Street and Cortland and Mitchell Streets southerly to the city line.

- A. Parking meters shall not be located in the sections where standing is to be prohibited.
- B. Standing on the Arterial Highway is to be prohibited as follows:
 - 1. On the east side of the Arterial Highway for a distance of one hundred (100) feet south of each of the southerly curb lines of Hale Street, Division Street, Hickok Avenue, Brown Avenue, Front Street, East Main Street and Mechanic Street.
 - 2. On the east side of Arterial Highway for a distance of fifty (50) feet north of each of the northerly curb lines of Hale Street, Division Street, Hickok Avenue, Brown Avenue, Front Street and Lackawanna Avenue.
 - 3. On the east side of the Arterial Highway:
 - a. Between the northerly curb line of East Main Street and the southerly curb line of East Park Place, except in the two (2) parking places permitted in this area.
 - b. Between the northerly curb line of East Park Place and the southerly curb line of Lackawanna Avenue.
 - c. Between the northerly curb line of Mechanic Street and the southerly curb line of Mitchell Street.
 - 4. On the west side of the Arterial Highway for a distance of fifty (50) feet south of each of the southerly curb lines of Chenango Avenue, Morse Avenue, Northrup Avenue, Beebe Avenue, Francis Avenue, Conkey Avenue, Eaton Avenue, Hayes Street, West Main Street and Fair Street.
 - 5. On the west side of the Arterial Highway for a distance of one hundred (100) feet of each of the northerly curb lines of Chenango Avenue, Morse Avenue, Northrup Avenue, Beebe Avenue, Francis Avenue, Conkey Avenue, Eaton Avenue, Hayes Street, West Main Street and Fair Street.

Standing on streets intersecting the Arterial Highway is to be prohibited as follows:

1. On the north side of the following streets for a distance of one hundred (100) feet east of their intersections with the Arterial Highway: Mitchell Street, East Main Street and Hale Street.

2. On the south side of the following streets for a distance of one hundred (100) feet west of their intersections with the Arterial Highway: Cortland Street, West Main Street, Northrup Avenue.

3. On the south side of the following streets for a distance of fifty (50) feet east of their intersections with the Arterial Highway: Mitchell Street, East Main Street and Hale Street.

4. On the north side of the following streets for a distance of fifty (50) feet west of their intersections with the Arterial Highway: Cortland Street, East Main Street and Northrup Avenue.

5. On the north and south sides of the following streets for a distance of fifty (50) feet east of their intersections with the Arterial Highway: Mechanic Street, Lackawanna Avenue, East Park Place, American Avenue, Hickok Avenue, Division Street, Jones Avenue, Hayward Avenue and Prentice Street.

6. On the north and south sides of the following streets for a distance of fifty (50) feet west of their intersections with the Arterial Highway: Fair Street, Hayes Street, Eaton Avenue, Conkey Avenue, Francis Avenue, Beebe Avenue, Morse Avenue and Chenango Avenue.

D. The following streets intersecting the Broad Street Arterial Highway shall be "STOP" intersections and appropriate "STOP" signs erected.

1. On Prentice Street, Hayward Avenue, Jones Avenue, Division Street, Hickok

Avenue, Brown Avenue, Front Street, East Park Place and Mechanic Street from the east.

2. On Chenango Avenue, Morse Avenue, Beebe Avenue, Francis Avenue, Conkey Avenue, Eaton Avenue, Hayes Street and Fair Street, which intersect the Arterial Highway from the west.

Section 525-38. Blank Section.

Part 2 Zones; Regulations

Section 525-39. Definition.

VEHICLE - As used herein, shall mean any device by which any person or property may be transported upon a highway, except those operated upon rails or tracks.

Section 525-40. Business District On-street Parking Zones.

The following described streets in the City of Norwich are hereby designated and established as Business District on-street parking zones, to wit: (1/1/99)

South Broad Street - Beginning on the easterly side thereof at its intersection with East Main Street thence southerly to a point 209 ft. south of American Avenue.

South Broad Street - Beginning on the westerly side thereof at its intersection with West Main Street thence southerly a point 119 ft. south of Hayes Street.

North Broad Street - Beginning on the easterly side thereof at its intersection with East Main Street thence northerly to the intersection of Mechanic Street.

North Broad Street - Beginning on the westerly side thereof at its intersection with West Main Street thence northerly to the intersection of Cortland Street.

East Main Street - Beginning on the southerly side from a point 219 ft. east of South Broad Street thence easterly to a point 391 ft. east of South Broad Street.

East Main Street - Beginning on the northerly side thereof at its intersection with East Park Place thence easterly to One City Plaza.

East Park Place - north and south sides.

West Park Place - Beginning on the southerly side thereof at its intersection with North Broad Street thence westerly to a point 209 ft. west of North Broad Street.

West Main Street - Beginning at the intersection with Broad Street thence westerly to Court Street on north side of street.

Section 525-41. Loading Zones.

BROAD STREET NORTH - west side, south of the intersection with Fair Street.

BROAD STREET SOUTH - east side, north of the intersection of American Avenue, one space.

BROAD STREET SOUTH - west side, south of the intersection of West Main Street, one space.

EATON AVENUE - south side, beginning at a point of 128 feet east of the intersection of Eaton Avenue and Elm Street for a distance of 50 feet to the end of loading zone.

HAYES STREET PARKING LOT - east side, one space.

LACKAWANNA AVENUE - south side, beginning at a point of 120 feet east of the intersection of North Broad Street for a distance of 50 feet to the end of the loading zone. (5/18/99)

Section 525-42. Police Zones.

- A. South Broad Street, one (1) space south of American Avenue.
- B. Hubbard Avenue, one (1) space east side of City Court.
- C. Court Street, east side adjacent to Sheriff's Office.
- D. West Park Place, north side adjacent to Sheriff's Office.

Section 525-43. School Zones.

- A. Definition: A school zone is any portion of the highway passing a school building for not more than three hundred feet in either direction from the building line of a school abutting on the highway. (Ref: NYS Vehicle & Traffic Law, Section 1643)
- B. The following streets are so designated:

Section 525-49. Reporting Violations.

It shall be the duty of officers so instructed to attach to such vehicle a notice reciting that it has been parked in violation of this ordinance, to take the parking meter number and the state vehicle tag number and expiration date of all vehicles violating the provisions of this ordinance a copy of notice shall be delivered to the Finance Office of the City of Norwich.

FAIR STREET, north side, from Court Street to Canasawacta Street from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

HAYES STREET, north side, from South Broad Street to Locust Street, from 8:00 AM to 6 PM, Saturday s and Sundays excepted. (7/21/98)

BUSINESS DISTRICT, On-street Parking Zone (1/1/99)

Section 525-52. City Parking Lots.

AMERICAN AVENUE CITY PARKING LOT, handicapped parking; three hour parking; all day parking.

EAST MAIN STREET CITY PARKING LOT, handicapped parking; fifteen minute parking; three hour parking; all day parking.

FAIR STREET CITY PARKING LOT, handicapped parking; fifteen minute parking; three hour parking.

HAYES STREET CITY PARKING LOT, handicapped parking; fifteen minute parking; three hour parking; permit parking; loading zone.

HENRY STREET CITY PARKING LOT, all day parking.

CITY PLAZA CITY PARKING LOT, handicapped parking; fifteen minute parking; three hour parking.

VIRGINIA LANE CITY PARKING LOT, handicapped parking, all day parking.

Section 525-53. Extending Time Beyond Maximum.

No vehicle shall remain in a timed parking space for more than the posted parking limit for that space. Every three hours constitutes a separate and distinct offense. (1/1/99)(7/17/01)

Section 525-54. No Parking.

- A. No parking on any city street from 12:00 AM to 6:00 AM effective November 1 through April 15. (10/18/16)
- B. No parking within thirty (30) feet of a stop sign.
- C. No parking within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant.
- D. No parking for a distance of fifty (50) feet from all street intersections within the City of Norwich.
- E. Specific streets:

ACADEMY STREET, south side.

ADELAIDE STREET, east side, from East Main Street to Sheldon Street.

AMERICAN AVENUE, both sides, from South Broad Street to Hubbard Avenue.

AMERICAN AVENUE, no parking except for loading and unloading.

BEEBE AVENUE, south side, for a distance of 65 feet east of Perry Browne School property line, from 1 PM to 3 PM on school days only.

BORDEN AVENUE, east side, from the railroad tracks, northerly for a distance of six hundred sixty nine (669) feet.

If any section, provision or part thereof in this chapter shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinances as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not so adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 525-78. When Effective.

This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1998.
